

## D-Backs give \$100,000 to schools and yours could be one of them

The Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation is now accepting applications for their annual "\$100,000 School Challenge."

The program is presented by the University of Phoenix with the goal to help benefit schools across the state of Arizona by funding.

This program started back in the spring of 2012 and received such an abundance of applicants the first year, the D-Backs have kept it going.

More than 3,500 applicants over the past six seasons have applied and the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation has been able to help more than 180 schools for a grand total of \$850,000 donated.

Teachers and administrators are invited to "make their best pitch" on why their school deserves the funding.

The contest is open to all Arizona public, private, and nonprofit charter schools, grades K-12. Applications are due by 4:59 MST on September 28, 2018 and can be found on the <u>Diamondbacks website</u>.

According to the Arizona Diamondbacks website, applications will be read and scored by a panel of Arizona Diamondbacks employees and University of Phoenix employees.

Winning schools will receive an estimated \$5,000 grant, adding up to a total of \$100,000. Grants will go towards improving, education programs, innovation and technology, nutrition and fitness and campus involvement.
